1. President Luanne Ferrer called the meeting to order at 10:05 a.m. in the Murrieta Library Community Room.

2. President's Message – Luanne Ferrer

- Bylaws changed passed without the change to Article VI, section 1 regarding the Treasurer and Secretary

- Mentioned that the Spring/Summer 2013 *Recreation Guide* is out and Library Programs are listed in the back (a PDF of the Recreation Guide can be viewed at: <http://www.murrieta.org/civica/filebank/blobdload.asp?BlobID=3079>); The “Read for a Reason” Program which is sponsored by Carol Carson, Summer Reading Program is coming up; 28 teens attended the interview tips program; March 18th was the Science of Slime with 28 kids and parents; Clint Perry and the BooHoo Crew is coming up March 26th; April 4th for ages 11-18 First Aid and CPR class for babysitters.
