1. Call to order at 10:02 AM
2. Minutes of April 15, 2014 approved with two corrections/additions on May 20, 2014
3. Treasurer's report - waiting for April 15th information from CPA.
4. Library Update - Laura Davis
  - a) In April the Library received an additional \$2,000 from LSTA (Library Services and Technology Act). This is in addition to the \$5,000 the Library received from LSTA to support the Common Core curriculum.
  - b) San Bernardino County has made some changes in their Library system: 1) patrons cannot place holds on books that belong to the San Bernardino County Library; 2) Library cards from San Bernardino County are no longer accepted.
  - c) The official summer reading program kicks off Monday, June 16 for children, teens and adults. FOML donated \$10,000 for performers and supplies. The teen component states for every page read and reported, one cent will be donated to the Animal Friends of the Valley, by the program sponsor Laurie Blanscet, DO.
  - d) June 3 is the next book club for adults - the selection is "Life After Life" by Kate Atkinson.
  - e) Deborah Villegas resigned her position as Page effective May 15. Interviews will be held May 2st and the position will be filled soon. Kirsten Short, Youth Services Library Assistant was welcomed to the library staff.
