2. Amended minutes approved by vote. Changes were to identify San Bernardino County as becoming a member of LSSI and are no longer members of the Inland Library Service; therefore Riverside County (and Murrieta) Library cards are no longer accepted.
3. Treasurer's report: Balance May 2, 2014: \$29,389.63, Membership and Renewals: \$80, Expenses:814.07, Bookstores sales and internet: \$9677.71, Bookstore Expenses: \$5764.77, Ending Bank Balance May 31,2014: \$32.550.31.

Library Update: a) Summer Reading began June 16th, b) San Bernardino County Library no longer part of Riverside County; their catalog and materials will not be listed in our Library Catalog; no sharing of materials, c) New Staff: Kristen in Children's and Teens and 2 new pages will start in July.
