They have a \$25,000 donation from the Municipal Water District to use for this project. There will be some grass removal also.

6. Corner Bookstore updates: Nancy Dixon reported the sales for the month and announced there will be a sidewalk sale on February 18th in front of the store.

7. Town Square store updates: The sales for the month were announced.
