- 6. Corner Bookstore Nancy Dixon
 - Gross Receipts for October: \$5,670: \$885.75 from the Overstock Sidewalk Sale; Internet -\$395; \$100 Donation; Total Income \$6,165; Expenses - \$5,006; Total Net Income: \$1,159
 - Introduced new member Artist Maxine Gillilan and how she came to display her paintings at the Corner Bookstore and teach painting classes at the bookstore.

Gary added that the FOML Board voted not to enter a push cart in the Holiday Parade this year due to scheduling conflicts.
