4. Library Update – Joyce Lea Brown

  - February is “Love Your Library” month and the “Food for Fines” program is in full force again. They are offering patrons the opportunity to have their fines waived in exchange for a non-perishable food item donation. 50¢ of fines will be waived for each item brought to the Library; up to \$10. The food collected is donated to the Murrieta United Methodist
  - The front entrance is going to have a new look soon. The Bradford Pear trees that were planted when the Library was built are now causing the cement to lift in certain areas and had become a tripping hazard. The trees were removed and Crêpe Myrtles will be planted in all but two of the planters.
  - Code Adam procedure has been put in place at the Library to assist and keep children safe in the Library. Code Adam was created in memory of six year old Adam Walsh and available through the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children. Their procedure was adapted from that and approved by the Murrieta Police Department. One recommendation made was to pay attention to your child’s shoe color, type and style. Most commonly changed by abductors is a hat, shirt or jacket but not shoes.
