# Friends of the Murrieta Library - General Meeting Tuesday, Sept. 17, 2013 10 a.m.

Treasurer Following the Agenda:

- 1. President Luanne Ferrer called the meeting to order at 9:59 a.m. in the Murrieta Library Community Room.
- 2. President Luanne Ferrer asked if there were any guests: Carl Stull introduced himself.
- 3. President's Message Luanne Ferrer
  - Welcomed us all back after being dark for July and August
  - Judy Call generously donated \$1,000 and we got \$325.38 in interest from the Murrieta Valley Town Hall Association Endowment Board to which we added \$25,000 from our non-interest bearing fund and deposited \$26,326.38 into the Dottie Renon Fund.
  - The Board agreed to participate in the Field of Honor again this year as a fundraiser.
  - An investment committee has been formed to try and increase our funds.
  - Reminded everyone to check our website frequently.
  - Asked for suggestions on how to increase our membership and get more members to attend meetings. Those suggestions will be in a future edition of the Booknotes.

- 5. Treasurer's Report Carol Carson (Hard copy of June, July and August's financial recap report is attached to Secretary's minutes as usual.) Financial recap available by request.
- 6. Library Update Laura Davis Adult/Young Adult Services Librarian:
  - The Library has made some management title changes and some City Hall departments have been combined.
  - Introduced new Supervising Librarian for Adult and Circulation Services person Agnes Rita
  - Informed us that Terri Mata is a new Library Assistants in the Children's Department and Terri Daniel moved from Children's to Adult Reference
  - 1,703 people signed up for Summer Reading!
  - They had 1,410 total reading participants and the teens which raised \$950 for the Animal Friends of the Valleys. Carol Carson rounded up and donated \$1,000 to the Animal Friends on their behalf.
  - Fines over \$5 can now be paid online
  - Fax services are now available to patrons
  - The City has paid for new copiers
