3. Treasurer's Report - Carol Carson

4. Library Update – Laura Davis

- Coincidentally today is also the Library's 8th Anniversary of the opening of this location (It is also St. Patrick's Day.)
- Children's Department going strong outlined programs coming up this month.
- Outlined Adult Programs coming up also
- Longtime Library Assistant Terri Daniels retired in February; they are looking to fill her position in the next four to six weeks
- There are four Archival Collections currently in process and they should be completed in four to six weeks as well. Asked for volunteers to help with copying, scanning and working with photos. If interested, give Laura a call
- 5. Historical Presentation Nancy Dixon

From Nancy's notes and the tape recording of the presentation:

"Post city-hood, c. 1991, Carol Kravagna and Dottie Renon:

- went to the County Library Board meetings to lobby for a library for Murrieta; County kept putting them off saying Murrieta might get a branch library or a mobile one.
- signed in as "Friends of the Murrieta Library"; Carol Kravagna said that they should have a Friends of the Murrieta Library and see what they could do as a group
- Carol and Dottie started buying books at garage sales and such and started a lending library in the old house by the Community Center
- on April 14, 1996 at the Fireman's BBQ they set up a booth with some books for sale to solicit members for the Friends of the Murrieta Library.
- Ended up with a wonderful charter group who held their first meeting on September 25, 1996
- Carol Kravagna found out that the amount of money that the Friends would be eligible for through property taxes designated for libraries could run a library; got help from the Librarian in Palm Springs who went through the county system and started their own library. She knew we could do it too.
- The group was going to city council meetings to withdraw from the county system and have our own library; city council ok'd the request on October 15, 1996. Continued on Page 2

- 5. Historical Presentation Nancy Dixon From Nancy's notes and the tape recording of the presentation:
- The county sent back "The Letter" saying that there was a loophole in the law that they were using so they would not have to give Murrieta the money from property taxes to have our own library
- Carol and friends worked with a State Legislator who was working on a bill to get that loophole closed; the bill passed in late 1998.
- Finally getting a library, they searched around and found the former Wells Fargo Bank on Los Alamos by Whitewood to rent so, on April 10, 1999 was the opening of the first Murrieta Library!
- June 1999, The Friends of the Murrieta Library opened a bookstore in the same shopping center
- In 2003, a bond was on the state ballot, that passed, giving money to libraries; Murrieta's own Diane Satchwell sent in an application and it was denied; she kept at it and on October 28, 2003 \$10M was approved!
- On June 24, 2005, Murrieta held the groundbreaking for its' new library! At that ceremony, Nancy, as Historian, said the following: "At last, this long awaited day is here. Today we have all come together: The Friends, the City, the Library. Today we remember, we celebrate, and we thank all those whose passionate dedication and diligent efforts have come together to make it possible for us to gather around this symbolic little scoop of earth on this spot which will soon blossom with Murrieta's very own Public Library!"
- Because of contractor bids, increased costs, whether or not there was going to be a Heritage Room and Garden of Verses, and various construction delays, construction finally started in the summer of 2006.
- On March 17, 2007 this fantastic facility finally opened!
- "Our acorn that was in a little pot over at the other Library now is in real soil and real ground where it all came together."
- Praised the Library Staff for how great they are at nurturing the Library and the community.
- Story boards on the side tables have photos of the opening
- On October 16, 2006, Loretta McKinney had a "Making Our Mark in History" gathering
  where the names and inscriptions of FOML members who were there are on the dry wall; it is
  now in the wall behind the check-in desk.
